I hereby release the Uvalde Festival and Events Association, Inc. and The Uvalde Area Chamber of Commerce and its representatives and assignees from all claims and liability relating to said photography.

RULES OF THE ROAD

ABSOLUTELY NO THROWING OF CANDY, GUM, ETC. FROM ANY ENTRY IN THE PARADE.

To do so will cause immediate expulsion from the parade and you may be ticketed by the Uvalde Police Department. It is against the rules to throw anything during the parade. Only those participants walking are allowed to pass things out to spectators along the parade route.

If you have people walking with your float, truck, etc., there will be no jumping on & off any moving vehicle. Please wait until the parade slows down and the vehicle is at a complete stop.

Walkers will not be allowed to walk besides moving vehicles; they must walk **BEHIND OR IN FRONT OF** the vehicles. Children who are riding on floats, trailers, trucks, etc. must be accompanied by adults at all times.

There is to be no littering either at the line up or down the parade route. If you must work on your entry at the lineup, please be sure to take everything with you. We are guests of the merchants in the area who graciously let us invade their parking lots.

Floats can not be more than 14ft. tall due to traffic light clearance.

If you break down during the parade, please move over to the side of the road as soon as possible. Some of the older cars will over heat excessively if they are not kept moving.

No alcoholic beverages are allowed at the lineup area or parade route.

Judges will be at the location to be determined. Number placement will be explained at time of sign in.

ENTRY FORM - Please fill out all of the form and be sure to circle what category you wish to be entered in for the judging. All entries must be received no later that 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 31, 2009. Entries received after that time will be placed at the end of the parade.

PARADE LINEUP – All entries will be notified of their entry number the week prior to the parade. Entries must be lined up by 10:00 a.m. **Parade starts at 11:00 a.m.**

AWARDS - Awards will be presented

The Parade Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, which they deem inappropriate or not representative of this community celebration. This includes any and all organized groups, which appear to be participating for the purpose of protesting for or against a cause.
